

THE POWER OF SOUND AND MUSIC RESEARCH

Extended Assignment: Infographic

PERSONAL OPINION QUESTIONS: Students should attempt to answer the following questions.

1. What are the origins of the type of music that you chose for your two poems?
2. Is it regional or specific to a certain culture?
3. Does it have its origins in another type of music that then evolved into the current genre?
4. What genre is the music currently identified with?
5. What are the demographics for the type of music you identified: (example: How popular is it? What age group? What regions? What groups of people are usually attracted to the music you like? What groups of people usually do not appreciate the genre or artists you chose?)

RESEARCH: If there are groups of students who have chosen similar genres they can work together on the research.

- Students will research and look for the answers to the Personal Opinion Questions.
- Students will use a variety of reliable sources. The Suggested resources for this unit can also be used.
- The information from the research will be clustered and organized by topic.
- Students will [create an infographic](#) (there are also tutorials on You Tube) [You Tube Tutorial on PowerPoint Infographic](#) to display the responses to the research questions.
- The infographic will also show a comparison chart between student response and what the research revealed.

CULMINATING ASSIGNMENT

FLIPBOARD Music Magazine

Student will now create a Flipboard online magazine to present the information.

The Flipboard will include:

1. The infographic
2. Information on prominent artists in the genre
3. Music samples of the genre researched and any other information of interest that will allow an audience to better understand the genre, its history and evolution.

How To CREATE YOUR MUSIC MAGAZINE:

PREPARING TO CREATE YOUR FLIP BOARD MAGAZINE.

- **Go To: [FLIPBOARD TOOLS](#)** Click on the icon that read [Flip it] and drag it to your tool bar.
This will allow you to easily “flip” add articles and sound cloud music into your magazine.
- **DOWNLOAD THE FLIPBOARD APP**



- **DOWNLOAD THE SOUND CLOUD APP**

NOW YOU ARE READY.

Go To: [FLIPBOARD SIGN IN](#). You can either sign in with your Google Account or create a Username and Password.

- In the upper right hand corner click on the icon that identifies your account.
- In the top tool bar to the right click on the pencil icon.
- Create your magazine where it reads [New Magazine]. Create a title for your magazine.
- There are many examples of Flipboard Magazines that you can browse for ideas or even articles that you might want to use.

SOUND CLOUD MUSIC

To choose music. **Go to [Sound Cloud Music](#).**

- Type the artist's name or the song into search.
- When you are choosing a song, make sure that it doesn't have [preview] at the bottom. If it does, you will not get the entire song.
- Always listen to the song to double check that you are choosing exactly what you want to play in your magazine.

HOW TO INCLUDE MUSIC AND ARTICLES INTO YOUR MAGAZINE.

When you find an online article that you want to include in your music magazine, simply

Click on the + Flip It on your task bar and it will be added to your magazine.

Organizing: You can move articles around in any order you choose.

Note: Sometimes there is a short delay between the time you flip an article or song into the Flipboard magazine and when it appears. Also, there is an app for the phone which seems to work more efficiently.
