Brainstorm on ways to educate fellow students about the difference between healthy and unhealthy relationships. Here are just a few suggestions.

EDUCATING THROUGH SURVEYS

1. Create brochures that have quick and easy accessible information to distribute after the survey.
2. Create a Google Survey that can also serve as a way on educating the person who is taking the survey.
 - a. Ask a series of questions and have the information on healthy and unhealthy relationships embedded in the question.
3. At the end of the survey give the student one of the informational brochures created.

AWARENESS THROUGH POSTERS

1. Create visually interesting posters that have information on the signs of healthy and unhealthy dating.
2. Choose a day to have posters posted around campus to inform students about the signs of healthy and unhealthy relationships.

GIVE AWARENESS PRESENTATIONS

1. Ask campus clubs (example: Mental Health Club) if you can give a presentation to the club members to provide them with information on healthy boundaries and healthy dating.
2. Create Brief Fun Informational Videos for the campus student produced video shows
3. Post Weekly Did You Know (Twitter or Instagram) Posts with Healthy Dating Facts.
